
F-M's Jarvis Receives State Coaching Honor

Dan Jarvis was voted Region III Coach of the Year for 1989-1990 season. It was the first of three such honors (1990-1991, 2006-2007). From 1983-1991 he guided the Raiders to a record of 157-62 and four conference championships. He came back for one year (2006-2007) to coach his son Ryan and led the Raiders to the Region III Division 3 Championship. From Waterford NY, he also played for the Raiders from 1974-1976. He was the 6th man on the 1974-75 team that was the number one defensive team in the NJCAA. Captain of the 1975-76 Raiders, Dan received MVCC All Star honors and the Raiders were conference co-champions. He went on to play for Springfield University in Massachusetts and had a successful professional career as a player/coach in Europe, before returning to FMCC as PE teacher and Basketball coach, where he established the highest winning percentage of any coach in school history at .727.



Rodney was a 5'9" lighting quick point guard from JFK in the Bronx. He had a smooth jump shot and was an excellent ball-handler, passer, and defender. An outstanding playmaker, he created a lot offense by driving to the hoop for a score or an assist. He led the 1983-1984 Raiders in Scoring (18.0), Assists (7.5) & Steals (1.8).


Dave was a 6'1" forward/guard from Tuckahoe, NY where he led his team to the NY State Class D Championship as a junior in 1981. As a senior he was selected to NYSSWA all-state 1st team, as Tuckahoe finished 2nd in the State Tourney. He was the kind of player who was not spectacular, but at the end of the game his stat sheet would be full. He was very strong in the paint and was a great defender.


MVCC All Star (1981-82) - Career FT% Record

1981-1982 averages: 10.2 points, 5.5 rebounds, 42.5% field goals, 82.3% free throws. 1983-84 averages: 11.8 points, 6.5 rebounds, 55.2% field goals, 81.4% free throws.

The 6'0" guard from William H Taft High School in Brooklyn NY had the kind of personality and basketball skills that were hard to ignore. An outstanding shooter from anywhere on the floor, he preferred to take the ball to the hoop. He was a strong finisher, good offensive rebounder, and excellent at getting to the free throw line. "J.C." averaged nearly six free throws per game and set the Raiders' career record with 82.0% accuracy.

1982-1983 & 1983-1984 FMCC Raiders - #44 Ed Salley

The 6'6" forward from William H Taft High School in Brooklyn was a talented low-post player. Ed had an outstanding 1983-1984 season scoring 17.5 per game, shot a high percentage (55.2%), and was a relentless rebounder. He established new FMCC records for single season (14.1) and career (11.0) rebound average.

1983-1984 & 1984-1985 FMCC Raiders - #34 Anthony King

The 6'4" All-City forward from William Penn High School in Philadelphia, PA was simply awesome. Unfortunately for Anthony (and the Raiders), he had trouble staying eligible. When he played, the Raiders were nearly unbeatable (17-3). He had a combination of power, quickness, and explosive leaping ability that made him unstoppable around the basket, and he shot well from outside as well, making nearly 60% of his field goal attempts. He played 10 games in the fall of 1983 and averaged 19.2 points and 11.7 rebounds. He came back for 10 more games in the fall of 1984 and was even better, averaging 29.5 points and 11.9 rebounds, including games of 40 and 49 points (an FMCC record). After FMCC, Anthony was a CIAA All-Star at Division II Powerhouse Shaw University, before spending several years playing professional basketball overseas and the CBA. Anthony was, without a doubt, one of the most talented players ever to play at FMCC.







Kevin went on to a successful basketball career at Alfred University where he led them to the NCAA Division III tournament in 1989. Kevin was an assistant coach for the Raiders from 1996-1998, under Tony Orapello.


He started up the women's basketball program in 1998. During his first four years, Kevin led the Lady Raiders to a record of 100-19 and established FM women's basketball as a powerhouse as they made four regional tournament appearances and one national tournament appearance. In his inaugural

season the Lady Raiders posted a record of 21-3 and made the regional tournament. Following a 20-7 record and another regional berth in 1999-2000, the Lady Raiders went 29-6, won the region 3 crown and reached the National Tournament and finished 8th in the nation. The Lady Raiders also won the region 3 title in 2004 where they had a record of 30-5 and made the national tournament. That year they finished ranked 4th in the country. The Lady Raiders have made the regional tournament in eight of their ten seasons (from 1998-2009) under Coach Jones en route to a career coaching record of 241-85 (.740).



It didn't matter if it was practice or a game; Leroy always played harder than anyone else and was usually the best player on the floor. He teamed with former Raiders' stars Darrell Mims and Greg Gumbs to lead the 1988 Lincoln squad to a 24-0 record before losing in the PSAL finals. The 6'4" Coney Island product was a coach's dream, with his exceptional athleticism, excellent skills, high basketball IQ, and relentless effort; Leroy seemingly could will his team to victory. An outstanding offensive player and rebounder, who often played above the rim, he also excelled on the defensive end, blocking shots and establishing a new Raiders' record for steals. He is definitely on the short list of all time great FMCC basketball players.

His son, Leroy "Truck" Fludd III, has followed in his footsteps, leading Boys and Girls High School in Brooklyn to 3 consecutive PSAL Championships (2010-2012). Truck was NY City Player-of-the-Year as Senior and his MVP performance led Boys & Girls to the NY State Federation AA Title. He followed that up by leading Jones County Community College to the NJCAA Division I Championship in 2014, again earning MVP honors.





1990-1991 FMCC Raiders - #33 Darrell Mims - MVCC MVP Region III All Star - All American

The 6'9" 270 pound, center from Lincoln High School in Brooklyn was a force to be reckoned with. He teamed with former Raiders' stars Leroy Fludd and Greg Gumbs to lead the 1988 Lincoln squad to a 24-0 record before losing in the PSAL finals. He transferred to FMCC for the 1990-91 season and led the Raiders to a 24-6 record and a 2nd place finish in Region III. In the process, Darrell established new FMCC records for rebounds in a season (450) and rebounds per game (15.0). He broke the single game rebound record with 27 vs HVCC (2/2/91), and then broke it again with a monster 30-point and 30-rebound game vs Champlain (3/10/91) in the Region III Championship game, establishing a new Region III Tournament rebound record in the process. He also averaged over 19 points per game and shot 58% from the field.

After FMCC, Darrell transferred to Seton Hall and was the starting center from 1991 through 1993. Seton Hall finished '91-92 with a sweet sixteen appearance in the NCAA tournament and a final ranking of 18th. The following year they were ranked 6th in the final NCAA poll. They also won the Big East Championship, defeating favored Georgetown in the tournament, as Darrell outplayed future NBA star Alonzo Mourning (pictured above).
