
Orapello receives coaching honor

JOHNSTOWN – It was a very rewarding season for Fulton-Montgomery Community College men's basketball coach Tony Orapello.

Orapello was named the National Junior College Athletic Association Division 3 Region 3 (District 1) Coach of the Year.

"I'll take it, the award is more prestigious. I'd rather be in the national championship than win the Mountain Valley Conference. It just means more," said Orapello.



Tony Orapello took over where Dan Jarvis left off, keeping the Raiders winning tradition established by Coach Fabiano. Like Fabiano, Tony took on an ambitious schedule against top-notch opponents. He coached FMCC for 15 successful seasons, and is the only Raiders coach to win two Region III Championships (1996 & 2000), receiving Region III Coach of the Year honors both times. He sent many players on to successful careers at four-year colleges, including Division I players Monroe Pippins (Florida A&M) and Sheridan James (Maryland Eastern Shore). He is also one of the most successful High School Girls Tennis coaches in NY State history, winning over 300 matches (3rd all-time) and 14 straight Big-Ten Championships at Amsterdam High School as of 2009.






1991-1992 FMCC Raiders - #32 Chris Skyers MVCC All-Star & Region III All-Star (1991-92)

Chris was a 6'5" forward from Midwood High in Brooklyn NY. A gifted athlete with exceptional speed, quickness, agility, and jumping ability, he was an excellent scorer and rebounder, averaging 19.5 and 12.2 respectively for the 1991-92 season. Chris finished his career as FMCC's all time leading rebounder and 6th in points scored. Chris transferred to Division II Saint Leo's College in Florida and continued his basketball career.

1991-1992 FMCC Raiders - #34 Jason Hammond

MVCC All-Star & Region III All-Star (1991-92)

Jason was a powerful 6'5" forward from South Shore High in Brooklyn NY. Outstanding in the paint, he averaged 14.6 points and 12.9 rebounds for the 1991-92 season. This included a 31-point 31-rebound game vs JCA (11/15/91), only the second 30-30 game in school history (Darrell Mims). The 31 rebounds also established a new Raiders' record. He finished his career as the Raiders' 3rd all-time rebound leader and in the top twenty for points scored. Jason, like Chris Skyers, transferred to Saint Leo's College in Florida and continued his basketball career at the NCAA Division II level. He now works as a Law Enforcement Officer in Miami.



1989-1990 & 1991-1992 FMCC Raiders - #44 Jim Clark MVCC All-Star (1991-92)

Jim was a 6'2" sharp-shooting guard from Amsterdam NY, who starred at Bishop Scully in High School. He made major contributions off the bench as a freshman and became a go to scorer in his second season. Jim finished the 1991-1992 season averaging 16.6 points and making a team record 77 three-point field goals.

1991-1992 & 1992-1993 FMCC Raiders - #20 Tim Griffin

Tim was a lightning-quick 6' point guard from West Milford NJ. He was excellent at breaking down the defense with his dribbling, setting up many scoring opportunities for himself and teammates. Tim dished out 18 assists in a game vs Cobleskill (11/21/91). He finished his career 4th on the all time FMCC assists list, fifth in steals, and in the top twenty for points scored.

1991-1992 & 1992-1993 FMCC Raiders - #30 Charles Branwell MVCC All-Star & Region III All-Star (1992-1993)

One of the best players ever to play for the Raiders, Charles was a 6'4" forward/guard from Prospect Heights High School in Brooklyn, NY. An outstanding scorer from the low-post to beyond the three-point arc and anywhere in between with an excellent ability for drawing fouls, Charles could score any way imaginable. He was also a great team player, and an excellent passer, rebounder, ball handler and defender. He recorded two career triple doubles and scored 20+ points an FMCC record 13 consecutive games during the 1992-1993 season. Charles is the only player in the history of FMCC Raiders Basketball to finish his career in the top ten for points scored (3rd), rebounds (4th), assists (6th), and steals (3rd). He is still in the top 10 in all four categories as of 2009.

1991-92 & 1992-93 FMCC Raiders - #33 Shawn Pratt

Shawn was a 6'4" forward/guard from Lincoln High School in Brooklyn NY. He possessed outstanding athletic ability and was equally adept at shooting threes or driving to the hoop for dunks. Shawn's game came straight from the Coney Island playgrounds, where he honed his skills. He was most at home with a run-and-gun style of play and averaged 12.1 points, 4.1 rebounds and 1.7 steals for his career. Shawn continued his education and basketball career at Southern Vermont after graduating FMCC and has since become a basketball coach.

1992-93 & 1993-94 FMCC Raiders – Captain #44 Wayne Brooks

Wayne was a 6'3" forward from Patterson NJ. He was a gifted athlete and an honor student in Accounting who also excelled as a sprinter for the FMCC track team. The captain of the '93-94 team epitomized what team basketball is all about. His speed, strength, and leaping ability were assets that along with his intelligence made him a great defender. He was also, probably the best passing forward in Raiders' history, averaging 6.2 assists per game for the '93-94 season, along with 13.0 points, 9.6 rebounds, and 2.5 steals; and established an FMCC record with four career Triple-Doubles. His leadership held the team together after several key players were lost for the season at the semester break, leaving the team depleted talent-wise. He never lost his intensity and never let his teammates quit as the team struggled through the second half of the season. Wayne continued his education and basketball career at SUNY New Paltz after graduating from FMCC.



MVCC All-Star - 14.7 points, 10.1 rebounds

Dave was a 6'4" forward from Northville, NY, who played his high school ball at Gloversville. He was a smart and versatile offensive player with the ability to score from the perimeter as well as the post. He was also an excellent rebounder. Dave shared Co-MVP honors for the Raiders with Wayne Brooks for the 1993-94 season, as the pair of sophomores did all they could to offset the loss of several key players for the second semester, including 6'4" forward Kris Mathis (17.8 points, 11.4 rebounds, 1.9 blocks, and 1.9 steals) and 6'5" forward Paul Douglas (6.1 points, 4.1 rebounds, 1.4 steals), as well as the starting point-guard Trevor Smalls.

After FMCC, Dave transferred to SUNY Albany; and now works as the Superintendent of the Gloversville Enlarged School District.

Trevor and Cito combined to form one of the best guard combinations in FMCC history, both obtaining Region 3 All-Stars status in their sophomore seasons (1994-95). Trevor averaged 14.4 points, 4.4 assists, and 2.5 steals, while Cito added 16.0 points, 3.1 assists and 1.7 steals in the 1994-95 season that saw the Raiders finish just two




wins short of a Region III Title.

Trevor only played the first semester in '93-94, averaging 12.9 points, 4.0 assists, and 2.4 steals. His absence, along with Kris Mathis and Paul Douglas, really caused the team to struggle in the second semester.





The '94-95 Raiders started off slowly with a 5-7 record, and they had just lost their leading scorer, forward Verol Gill with his 21.3 points and 9.7 rebounds, for the season. It appeared to be a lost year. The coaches decided it was time to play their best three players together, despite the fact that they were all guards. Smalls, Pippins, and Brown proceeded to turn the season around for the Raiders. They combined to average over 50 points, 15 assists and 10 steals per game the rest of the way. At the same time, both Andrew Francis and Barceem Dukes picked up their games and dominated the backboards; Francis setting a new record in the process with 33 rebounds in one game. This group, with some help from 6th man Adrian Kenyon, won 14 of their next 18 games before losing in the Regionals in a close game to eventual champ Corning. All three of the All-Star guards fouled out in the closing minutes. It was a disappointing loss, but a memorable season.

"Bar" was a 6'4" forward/guard from Brooklyn. He teamed with Stephon Marbury at Lincoln High as the Railsplitters went to back-to-back PSAL Championship games. Bar was an outstanding athlete with excellent speed, quickness, jumping ability, and strength. He played hard all the time and was an excellent rebounder and a defensive standout with the ability to guard anyone on the floor. Bar was versatile offensively, as well, even

playing some point guard, and shot well from the perimeter (42% on 3's in '95-96). His basketball skills and intensity were key factors for the Raiders in winning the 1995-1996 Region III Championship.

His son, Barceem Jr, played for the Raiders from 2014-2016, achieving All-Star status his second year.


After seeing limited action as a freshman due to a broken hand in the 1992-93 season, Drew blossomed into a force in 1994-95. He set the FMCC single game rebound record by hauling down 33 vs Adirondack (02/23/95). The 6'6" forward averaged 9.7 points, 12.5 rebounds & 3.0 blocked shots for the season. He finished his career with the Raiders as one of the all-time leaders in rebounds and blocked shots.

Francis, who played for Lincoln HS in Brooklyn NY before coming to FMCC and LIU after, is now passing on his basketball knowledge as an Assistant-Coach for the University of California after several very successful years coaching with Iowa, Siena and Villanova. He has been coaching at the Division-1 Level since 2005.

Always a winner, Monroe led Walton High School to the 1993 New York City PSAL Championship his senior season, before leading the Raiders to a Region III Championship in 1996. The 6'1" guard then scored an NJCAA Tournament record 48 points in one game at the 1996 Nationals. In 1999, he would lead underdog Florida A&M to the MEAC Championship, receiving MVP honors in the process. Monroe finished 9th in NCAA Division I Scoring for the 1998-99 season with a 20.5 points-per-game average, including 23 points vs Duke in the NCAA Tournament. Based on statistics, Monroe was the greatest player in Raiders' History. There are a few others deserving of consideration, but it can be certain that no one was better.






Raiders ready for NJCAA play

1995-1996 FMCC Raiders - #11 Qaddafi Alonzo Season Averages: 10.3 Points, 5.9 Assists, 2.9 Steals.

Qaddafi was a 5'10" guard from Madison High School in Brooklyn. He had all the qualities that a coach is looking for in an outstanding point guard. He was fast, and could dribble, pass, shoot, and defend at a high level. Most of all he was an excellent leader with a Championship heart. He was also very tough, a real warrior, playing the entire season with a dislocated shoulder that required surgery as soon as the season was over. Many times it popped out during a game, and we'd just pop it back in and he'd be ready to play.



1995-1996 FMCC Raiders - #50 Terrell Williams -Team Captain.

Season Averages: 8.5 Points, 6.5 Rebounds, 2.1 Assists.

Terrell was a 6'5" forward from New Utrecht High School in Brooklyn, NY. He was an excellent all-around player. He excelled at doing the stuff that often goes unnoticed, except by a coach. He could have scored a lot more points but sacrificed for the team, instead setting up teammates with passes and screens. He was also a tremendous defender, helping the Raiders become one of the best defensive teams in the nation. His play and leadership were major factors in FMCC's Championship season. He went on to graduate from SUNY Cortland and become a teacher and head varsity basketball coach at the Academy of Environmental Science in Manhattan. Terrell is a true leader and an excellent role model.





One of the all-time great Raiders, Arturo was a 6'5" forward from Lincoln High School in Brooklyn, NY. A tremendous athlete, he was a major force for the 1996 Region III Championship team, leading the team in rebounds and second in scoring, winning the MVP award in the Regional Tournament, and receiving All-Tournament honors at the Nationals. He accomplished all of this his freshman year despite playing with a high-ankle sprain on one foot and a stress-fracture in the other, which required surgery as soon as the season ended. He put up even bigger numbers his sophomore season and was selected for a second time to the Region III All-Star team. Arturo finished his career breaking the Raiders' record for career rebounds (648) and established a new record for rebounding average (12.46) as well. He also is one of FMCC's all-time leading scorers with 969 points (5th all-time) for an 18.6 average (also 5th). After FMCC, Arturo transferred to Division II powerhouse Shaw University to continue his basketball career. Arturo come back to FMCC to contribute to the basketball program as an assistant coach since 2008.

Sheridan was a 6'8" forward/center from Sheepshead Bay High School in Brooklyn NY. Sheridan came to the Raiders as a raw talent, but soon began to develop. By the second semester of his freshman year he really began to play consistently well off the bench. His rebounding, defense, and inside scoring were major factors for the Raiders in winning the 1996 Region III Championship. By the time his sophomore year rolled around Sheridan was a force to be reckoned with. He averaged 14.7 points, 12.3 rebounds, 2.3 blocks and shot 55.8% from the field for the season. He finished his career in 3rd place on the Raiders all time Rebound list and went on to play Division I basketball at the University of Maryland Eastern-Shore where he was a starting forward/center from 1998-2000.






1999-2000 FMCC Raiders – Twin Towers #54 Josh Tesi - #52 Dan Amell

The biggest tandem in FMCC history, Tesi (7'0") and Amell (6'10") were a formidable defensive presence for the 1999-2000 Raiders, blocking shots in record numbers and generally controlling the paint and intimidating opposing shooters. Tesi was unavailable to play in the NJCAA Tournament; and his absence definitely hindered the Raiders' chances to win a National Championship.

Josh returned to the Raiders for the 2002-2003 season and was selected All-Conference. He averaged 9.0 points and 11.7 rebounds, and played his usual great defense as the Raiders compiled an impressive 24-8 record.

1999-2000 FMCC Raiders – Celebrate their Region III Tournament Championship

The Raiders were long known as a man-to-man defensive team that utilized speedy guards and athletic forwards to pressure opposing teams full-court. This team, however, was not built that way. After a mediocre start Coach Orapello decided to employ a new strategy, taking advantage of the type of talent this team had. He went to a 1-2-2-zone defense that featured his two centers playing at the same time, 7'0" Gloversville NY High School star Josh Tesi and 6'10" Shenendehowa High School star Dan Amell. Tesi would play at the top of the zone, harassing shooters with his long wingspan. At the same time, Amell and 6'4" All-American forward Michael Beaton defended the paint. Amell set new Raiders' records for blocked shots; and Beaton, with his great quickness and jumping ability, hauled down most of the missed shots, leading the nation in rebounding. The guards played the wings, using their speed to quickly closeout on shooters. The new defense sent the Raiders on a winning tear all the way to the Region III Championship. Point guard Steve Mazier led the way in the Regionals, earning MVP honors, while Michael Beaton also was also named to the All-Tournament team.
